Mahalo for signing up to participate in the Hawai'i Organ Donor Enrollment Day campaign on Thursday, April 8, 2021, when our goal will be to register as many organ, eye and tissue donors in Hawai'i as possible!

Today more than 350 friends and family members in our community are waiting for a lifesaving organ transplant. Many of them have been waiting for more than five long years. You may not know them, but these are our brothers, sisters, friends and neighbors. Sadly, some of them die each year because the organ they need did not become available in time.

With your aloha and team efforts, we hope to reach more people in Hawai'i than ever before – anyone over the age of 18 who lives in Hawai'i can enroll in the Hawai'i Donate Life Registry and document his or her decision to be a donor. There are no age or medical restrictions.

Did you know that one person can save eight lives as an organ donor, and restore sight and mobility for up to 75 more as an eye and tissue donor? On April 8th, let's share our aloha as a community and demonstrate our superpower to save and heal lives.

Enclosed in this toolkit, you will find the resources you need to promote Hawai'i Organ Donor Enrollment Day to your 'ohana, friends, neighbors, co-workers and anyone else you know.
